Discussion ensued on the need to outreach to the community and provide an outreach for all services.

Lisa Gourley suggested adding warming shelter flyers at check stands to have a mechanism to get the word out. Nazarene church has limited space per square foot and some limitations such as no animals, which prevents some of most vulnerable populations from utilizing the shelter. Bob Dalton noted that building space issues could be a concern in the future.
