Goal #2 Landing Pad – it was agreed the New City Hall would be an ideal location for this site. Goal #3 Web Links to health care – this goal has been completed.

Good of the Order:

Jim Gourley presented a banner example for the Hero Banner Project. Mr. Gourley explained there are 230 poles along Main Street. Banners are expected to cost about \$75 and brackets will be additional. The banners would be hung in honor of deployed/stationed veterans, Gold Star Families, or veterans from Memorial Day until Veterans Day. Mr. Gourley is partnering with the Elks and the VFW.
