ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102 AS AMENDED PROVIDING FOR THE NAMING OF STREETS, THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS, PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 102 passed by the Council on April 11, 1944 and approved by the Mayor on April 14, 1944, entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE NAMING AND RE-NAMING OF STREETS, THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS, PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" as amended by Ordinance No. 108, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3. SYSTEM OF NAMING STREETS: With the west city limits as a base line, all streets running generally north and south shall be called "avenues" and shall be numbered from west to east, e. g. "1st Avenue", "2nd Avenue", etc.

With the south city limits as a base line, all streets running generally east and west shall be called "streets" and shall be lettered in alphabetical order from south to north, e. g. "A Street", "B Street", etc.

With 1st Avenue as a base line, all streets running generally north and south, lying westerly of and parallel to 1st Avenue, being designated as "place", e. g. "1st Place", "2nd Place", etc.

All streets and avenues lying between regularly designated streets and avenues be designated as "lanes", e. g. "A Lane", "B Lane", etc., and "1st Lane", "2nd Lane", etc.

Where streets are 300 feet apart, more or less, provision shall be made for inclusion of future streets within the system.

Section 5. SUBSTITUTION OF NAMES ON STREETS ALREADY NAMED: Following is the list of existing street names and the corresponding names placed in effect by this ordinance:
