

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 7 FOR 1954

ORDINANCE NO. 272

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 122 AS AMENDED REGULATING PARKING, PROVIDING PENALTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 122 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor April 11, 1946, entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE VEHICULAR TRAFFIC IN PUBLIC WAYS" as amended by Ordinances 168, 198 and 203, is hereby amended by the addition of the following section:


Section 4 (b). It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or trailer between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M. on Saturday at any point on M Street between Holley Road and 19th Avenue, or at any point on L Street between 10th Avenue and 13th Avenue or at any point on 12th Avenue between M Street and L Street, or at any point on the 13th Avenue between M Street and L Street.

Section 2. The Council deems it expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately, and an emergency exists affecting the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Sweet Home, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its being passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
