

Ordinance Bill No. 5 for 1954

Ordinance No. 270

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALL ORDINANCES WHICH REFER TO AND INCORPORATE OREGON CODES AND STATUTES, TO INCORPORATE BE REFERENCE THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF OREGON REVISED STATUTES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Each ordinance of the City of Sweet Home which refers to any statute of the State of Oregon or incorporates any statute, code, compilation or session law of Oregon is hereby amended by the substitution therein of the corresponding reference to Oregon Revised Statutes and the provisions thereof.

Section 2. Since Oregon Revised Statutes is now in force and effect the council deems it expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately and an emergency exists affecting the peace and safety of the citizens of Sweet Home, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
