

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 17 FOR 1948
ORDINANCE NO. 155

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE
NO. 76 AS AMENDED.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 76,
passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor the 10th
day of June, 1941, and amended by Ordinance No. 115, passed
by the Council and approved by the Mayor the 26th day of
June, 1945, be amended to provide and read as follows:

Section 8. FIRE LIMITS. That the following
described territory be and the same is here-
by declared to be within and to constitute
the fire limits of the City of Sweet Home,
to-wit, all that certain territory within
the city limits of said City of Sweet Home,
described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the south
line of "M" street with the west line of
18th avenue and running thence southerly
to the intersection of the north line of
"L" street with the west line of 18th avenue;
thence in a westerly direction along the
north line of "L" street to the intersection
of the north line of "L" street with the
east line of 13th avenue; thence south to
the point of intersection with a line para-
llel to and 100 feet south of the south
line of "L" street; thence in a westerly
direction along said parallel line to the
center of Ames Creek; thence northwesterly
along the center of the channel of Ames
Creek to the point of intersection with a
line parallel to and 100 feet south of the
south line of "M" street; thence westerly
along said parallel line to the point of
intersection with the north boundary of
"L" street; thence along said north bound-
ary of "L" street to the point of inter-
section with the south boundary of Holley Road;
thence north to the point of intersection with
a line parallel to and 100 feet north of the
north boundary of "M" street; thence easterly
along said parallel line to the west line of
18th avenue; thence southerly 160 feet to
the point of beginning.
