

RESOLUTION NO. 6 FOR 2014

A RESOLUTION CLARIFYING THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS RELATED TO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR THE LINN COUNTY HOUSING REHABILITATION PARTNERSHIP HOME REPAIR PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Sweet Home was the recent recipient of a Community Development Block Grant for the implementation of the Linn County Housing Rehabilitation Partnership Home Repair Program for Linn County, which was assigned Project Number H13012.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program typically provides that the City's highest elected official, which would be the Mayor, executes documents related to the Block Grant Program;

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program also provides for the option for a City to designate a person other than the Mayor to have the authority to execute documents associated with a grant awarded under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, for previous grants which have been awarded to the City under the Community Block Development Program, the City's City Manager has been actively involved in the administration of the grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby appoints the City Manager as the Federal Certifying Officer for the Linn County Housing Rehabilitation Partnership Home Repair Program associated with the Oregon Community Development Block Grant No.H13012.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
