

Resolution 9 FOR 2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT (TGM) PROGRAM GRANT UPDATING THE CITY'S TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN TO COMPLY WITH STATE TRANSPORTATION PLANNING RULE (GOAL 12 ADMINISTRATIVE RULE, OAR 660-12).

WHEREAS, Oregon law requires that state, local, and regional governments adopt interrelated Transportation Systems Plans (TSPs). The purpose of local TSPs, according to the Transportation Planning Rule, is to "establish a system of transportation facilities and services adequate to meet identified local transportation needs consistent with regional transportation plans (RTPs) and adopted elements of the Oregon Transportation Plan"; and

WHEREAS, TSPs should be updated regularly to reflect changing conditions; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2005 the City Council adopted the current Sweet Home Transportation Systems Plan (TSP) via Ordinance No. 1172; and

WHEREAS, since adoption of the current Sweet Home TSP, many critical land-use decisions have been made, rendering the need to update the TSP to determine the composite effects of these land-use decisions on the City's system of streets, and multi-modal facilities; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is accepting applications for the TGM Program which include requests to update existing Transportation System Plans (TSP); and


WHEREAS, the Transportation Growth Management Program, a joint program of Oregon Department of Transportation and Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development, has invited grant applications for the 2015 grant cycle; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified and allocated up to \$120,000 in the recently approved 2015-2016 operating budget for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sweet Home as follows:

- The City Council hereby authorizes City staff to submit an application to the Department of Land Conservation and Development and the Oregon Department of Transportation for a Transportation and Growth Management program grant thereby allowing the city to update the City's Transportation System Plan to effect compliance with Transportation Planning Rule OAR 660-012.0045
- This Resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
