RESOLUTION NO. 11 FOR 2004

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE OREGON JAMBOREE STREET & PARK CLOSURES.

WHEREAS, on July 30, through August 1, 2004, the Oregon Jamboree will hold a concert requiring street and park closures; and

WHEREAS, traffic patterns and parking issues need to be addressed to accommodate the events; and

WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 10.04.030 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control;

WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 12.12.010 and Sweet Home Charter Section 2 provide that the City can limit park use and has the power to conduct municipal affairs;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Sweet Home does resolve as follows:

Traffic and park regulations shall be kept in effect as follows:

- A. From 7:00 a.m. on July 30, 2004 to 9:00 p.m. on August 1, 2004 18th Avenue from Long Street to Grape Street shall be closed and blocked off to through vehicular traffic at the direction of the Chief of Police or his designated representative; provided, residential traffic, with no alternate routes, will be allowed ingress and egress. The portion of 18th Avenue immediately adjacent to the concert grounds and serving no residential properties, shall be completely blocked off to all unauthorized vehicles: In addition, during the above time period, all areas of 18th Avenue between Long Street and the concert grounds shall be designated and signed as Disabled Parking Only and the Chief of Police is directed to enforce the provisions of ORS 811.615.
- B. From 12:01 p.m. on July 29 through 11:59 a.m. on August 2, Sankey Park shall be closed to all persons except those authorized by the Oregon Jamboree or the Chief of Police, except that the lower park shall not be closed to casual day users prior to 6:00 a.m. on 7-30-04.
- C. Appropriate signs or other markings shall be installed to carry out the provisions of this resolution, and shall become effective immediately upon the installation of such signs or other markings.
