RESOLUTION NO. 15 FOR 2004

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO SCHOOL ZONES.

Whereas, Sweet Home Municipal Code Section 10.04.030 provides that the City Council may by resolution establish or alter traffic and parking control;

Whereas, the City Council is the Road Authority for the City of Sweet Home under Oregon State Law;

Whereas, the City Council as Road Authority wishes to establish and comply with placing signs in and by the school zones in the City of Sweet Home to inform drivers that certain state laws are enforced in said zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Sweet Home does hereby resolve as follows:

That signage shall be placed in, by or near all school zones in the City of Sweet Home in conformance with and to carry out the provisions of ORS 801.462 for school zones, ORS 810.245 for signage giving notice of consequences of traffic offenses committed in school zones, ORS 811.235 pertaining to fines for traffic offenses in school zones, ORS 811.111 for violating speed limits in school zones and ORS 811.109 for penalties for speed violations in school zones.

This resolution shall be effective upon the placement of the signs and in full force and effect upon the sign installation.

This resolution is passed to confirm, establish and reaffirm any signage that establishes the school zones, the cross walks, the State speed limits and the signage that carries out the intention of the legislature in regard to the above referred to Oregon Revised Statutes.

This resolution is to conform with Oregon Revised Statutes but does not negate any authority given to the City directly by said statutory process or other laws or ordinances.
