RESOLUTION NO. 17 FOR 2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OR ALTERATION OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS ON LONG STREET BETWEEN $15^{\rm TH}$ AND $22^{\rm ND}$ AVENUES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 380 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Sweet Home has considered and does recommend the traffic controls referred to in item 1 be established;

WHEREAS, the Sweet Home School District no longer requires restricted parking near the front of the Sweet Home High School and the Public Works and Police Department are in agreement that items 2 and 3 be established;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) That two (2) "Stop" signs regulating traffic on Long Street at 22nd Avenue be installed; one on the Southwest corner of the intersection regulating eastbound Long Street traffic, one on the Northeast corner of the intersection regulating westbound Long Street traffic and creating a 4-way stop intersection to be in full force and effect upon sign installation.
- 2) On the South side of Long Street from 15th Ave to 18th Ave, all 2hr and No Park zones to be removed. Yellow No Park zones at appropriate setbacks from traffic control devices, mid-block crosswalk and fire hydrants to remain, or be installed.
- 3) On the North side of Long Street, from 18th Ave to a point 290' East of 15th Avenue, all 2hr and No Park zones are to be removed. Yellow No Park zones at appropriate setbacks from traffic control devices, mid-block crosswalk and fire hydrants to remain, or be installed.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
