

RESOLUTION NO. 19 FOR 2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A "NO PARKING" ZONE ON THE WEST SIDE OF 18TH AVENUE SOUTH OF LONG STREET WITH SIGNAGE AND YELLOW CURB.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 380 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee of the City of Sweet Home has considered and does recommend the following traffic controls be established,


THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

That a No Parking Zone with regulatory "No Parking" signs and a yellow painted curb, be established regulating traffic and parking on the west side of 18th Avenue extending from 460 feet south from the center of Long Street to 800 feet south from the center of Long Street, and be in full force and effect upon sign installation.

THIS resolution repeals Resolution No. 4 for 2002.


THIS resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

PASSED by the City Council and approved by the Mayor this 24th day of August, 2004.

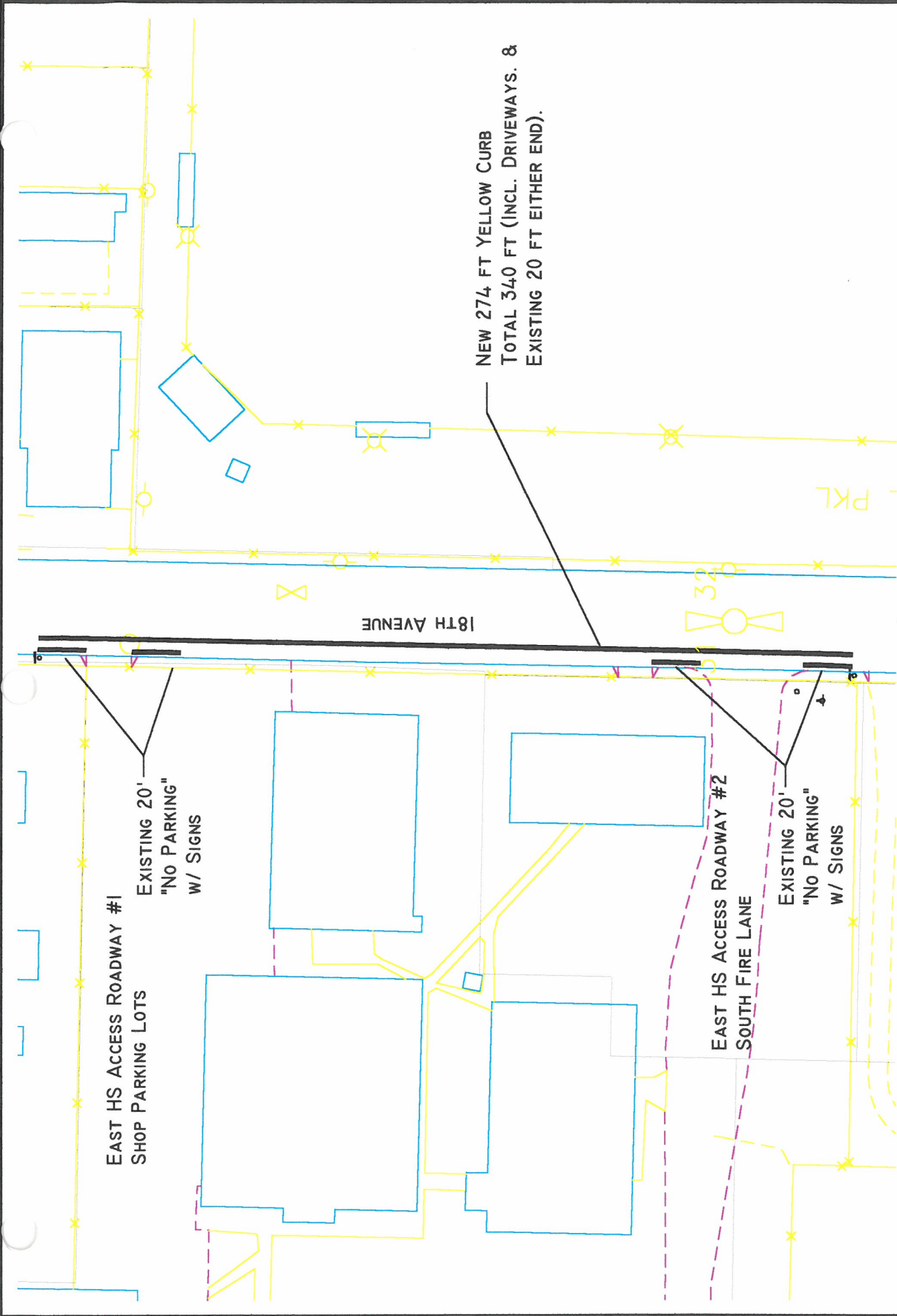

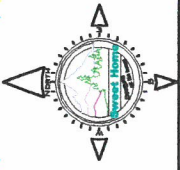
