

RESOLUTION NO. 27 FOR 2004

**A RESOLUTION SETTING FEES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MEASURE 37 ORDINANCE, AS MADE A PART OF SWEET HOME MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 3.30.**

WHEREAS, the City of Sweet Home has adopted an ordinance for the processing of Demand For Compensation claims; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is to set fees to cover the costs of processing these claims; and

WHEREAS, the City must establish fees by Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following fees will be effective as of December 2, 2004:

1. Application Deposit: \$500
2. Actual costs incurred in processing an application, including staff time, attorney fees, and acquisition of required information.


Upon finalizing the Decision Resolution of the City Council, the City Manager will send a bill to the applicant, which is payable within 30 days. If the applicant does not pay the amount due, the City may pursue all forms of collection available, including filing of a lien on the property.

Any portion of collected fees not expended in the processing of a Demand For Compensation claim will be refunded to the applicant within 30 days of the Decision Resolution.

It has been determined that these rates and fees are classified as not being subject to Oregon Constitution, Article XI, Section 11b limitations.

This Resolution shall be effective December 2, 2004, upon its passage.
