RESOLUTION NO. 6 for 2009

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME TO PURCHASE TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, ONLY PRODUCTS AND SERVICES THAT ARE MADE OR PERFORMED IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA WHENEVER AND WHEREVER POSSIBLE WITH ANY ECONOMIC RECOVERY MONIES PROVIDED TO THE CITY OF SWEET HOME BY THE AMERICAN TAXPAYERS.

WHEREAS, the economic downturn is having a critical impact on everyday Americans who are struggling to maintain or find jobs in an increasingly difficult environment; and

WHEREAS, those same Americans are taxpayers that provide the revenue needed to operate essential government services; and

WHEREAS, Congress has approved and President Obama has signed into law a taxpayer-sponsored economic recovery package that will provide billions of dollars to help economically devastated cities and states immediately provide jobs to millions of out-of-work Americans through considerable infrastructure rebuilding, green energy projects and other projects that will require manufactured components; and

WHEREAS, our taxpayer dollars should be spent to maximize the creation of American jobs and restoring the economic vitality of our communities; and

WHEREAS, any domestically produced products that are purchased with economic recovery plan monies will immediately help struggling American families and will help stabilize our greater economy; and

WHEREAS, any economic recovery plan spending should – to every extent possible – include a commitment from the City of Sweet Home to buy materials, goods and services for projects from companies that are produced within the united States, thus employing the very workers that pay the taxes for the economic recover plan spending in the first place.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Sweet Home will work to maximize the creation of American jobs and restoring economic growth and opportunity by spending economic recovery plan funds on products and services that both create and help keep Americans employed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Sweet Home commits to purchasing only products and services that are made or performed in the United Sates of American whenever and wherever possible to the extent practicable, with any economic recovery monies provided to the City of Sweet Home by the American taxpayers; and

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City of Sweet Home commits to publish any requests to waive these procurement priorities so as to give American workers and producers the opportunity to identify and provide the American products and services that will maximize the success of our nation's economic recovery program.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
