RESOLUTION NO. 14 FOR 2010

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE OREGON JAMBOREE, PARK CLOSURES, STREET CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS, on July 30th and 31st, and August 1, 2010 the Oregon Jamboree will hold a concert requiring street and park closures; and

WHEREAS, traffic patterns and parking issues need to be addressed to accommodate the events; and

WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 10.04.030 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control;

WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 12.12.010 and Sweet Home Charter Section 2 provide that the City Manager can limit park use.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Sweet Home does resolve as follows:

Traffic and park regulations shall be kept in effect as follows:

- A. From 7:00 a.m. on July 30th to 9:00 p.m. on August 1st, 2010 18th Avenue from Long Street to Grape Street and 14th Ave from Kalmia Street to Hawthorne Street shall be closed and blocked off to through vehicular traffic at the direction of the Chief of Police or his designated representative; provided, residents living within the blocked off area, with no alternate routes, will be allowed ingress and egress.
- B. From 11 a.m. on July 29th to 9:00 p.m. on August 1st, 2010, the portion of 18th Avenue immediately adjacent to the concert grounds and serving no residential properties, shall be completely blocked off to all vehicular traffic:
- C. From 5:00 p.m. on July 29th to 9:00 p.m. on August 1st, 2010, all areas of 18th Avenue between Long Stree; and the concert grounds shall be designated and signed as Disabled Parking Only and the Chief of Police is directed to enforce the provisions of ORS 811.615:
- C. From 6:00 a.m. on July 27th through 8:00 p.m. on August 2nd 2010, Sankey Park shall be closed to all persons except those authorized by the Oregon Jamboree or the Chief of Police and signage and fencing shall be in place to effect the safe closure:
- D. Appropriate signs or other markings shall be installed to carry out the provisions of this resolution, and shall become effective immediately upon the installation of such signs or other markings.
