

RESOLUTION NO. 22 FOR 2011

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING STREET CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS, August 2nd, 2011 has been designated as National Night Out Against Crime; and

WHEREAS, The Nandina Street Neighborhood Watch group wishes to participate by holding an area BBQ and get-together as part of this program; and

WHEREAS, traffic patterns and parking issues need to be addressed to safely accommodate the event; and


WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 10.04.030 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Sweet Home does resolve as follows:

Traffic regulations shall be kept in effect as follows:


- A. From 5:30 PM to 9:30 PM on August 2nd, 2011, 13th Avenue from Nandina Street, south to the alleyway between Nandina and Main Street, shall be closed and blocked off to all vehicular traffic. The alleyways and private parking lot access points, intersecting 13th Avenue between Long Street and Main Street, shall remain open.
- B. Appropriate signs or other markings shall be provided by the Public Works Department to safely carry out the provisions of this resolution, and shall become effective immediately upon the installation of such barricades, signs or other markings.
