AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 628, PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY: DISPENSING WITH A CITY ELECTION ON THE QUESTION: FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING: AND DIRECTING THAT NOTICE BE PUBLISHED AND POSTED.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 628 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 3. Public Hearing. That a public hearing on the question of annexation shall be held at the City Hall of Sweet Home on January 8, 1974 at 8:00 o'clock p.m. at which time the registered voters of the City may appear and be heard on the question of annexation.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
