

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY.

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Sweet Home a written proposal for annexation to the city by more than two-thirds of the landowners who also own more than two-thirds of the land in the contiguous territory described below which real property there-in represents more than two-thirds of the assessed value of all real property in the contiguous territory to be annexed:

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 621 was passed, initiating the annexation of said territory, calling a hearing and directing that notice be given thereon, and since the hearing was held at which time all objections or remonstrances with reference to said proposed annexation were considered by the Common Council and since that body feels that annexation is to the best interest of the City and of the contiguous territory;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation Area. The following described contiguous territory is hereby proclaimed to be annexed to the City of Sweet Home:

TRACT I: Beginning at a point S 0° 01' W, 286.82 feet and S 88°59' E, 411.00 feet from the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T.14 S., R.1 E, W.M. in Linn County, Oregon; thence S 88°59' E, 137.00 feet; thence N 0° 01'E, 143.42 feet; thence N.88°59' W, 137.00 feet; thence S 0° 01' W, 143.42 feet to the point of beginning.

TRACT II: Beginning on the North line of and S 89°26' E, 411.00 feet from the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6. T. 14S., R.1E., W.M. in Linn County, Oregon; thence S 0°01' W, 146.65 feet to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe; thence S 88°59' E, 137.00 feet; thence N 0°01' E, 96.24 feet to the south line of the Oregon Electric Railroad right-of-way; thence N 59°17' W along said right-of-way to its intersection with the north line of Sec. 6 in said T. 14S., R.1.E., W.M.; thence N 89°26' W, along said North line of Sec. 6, 51.30 feet more or less to the place of beginning.

TRACT III: Beginning at a point S 0°01' W, 286.82 feet and S 88°59' E, 274.00 feet from the NW corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6, T. 14S., R.1E., W.M. in Linn County, Oregon; thence S 88°59 E, 137.00 feet; thence N 0°01' E, 143.42 feet; thence N 88°59' W, 137.00 feet; thence S 0° 01' W, 143.42 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. Record. The City Recorder shall submit to the Secretary of the State of Oregon (1) a copy of this ordinance, (2) a copy of the statement of consent of the landowners in the territory annexed, and (3) a copy of Ordinance No. 621 dispensing with an election in the city on the question of annexation. The City Recorder shall also send a description by metes and bounds, or legal subdivisions, of the new boundaries of the city within ten(10) days of the effective date of annexation to the Linn County Assessor and Linn County Clerk.


Section 3. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance

is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval of the Mayor.
