

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 33 FOR 1953

ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 261  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Section 6 of Ordinance No. 261 is hereby amended to

read as follows:


Before the issuance of a registration card, the registrant shall file with the Building Inspector a certificate from a public liability insurance company qualified to do business in the State of Oregon to the effect that the registrant carries with such company public liability and property damage insurance in the amount of \$5000 property damage, \$5000 for injuries or death of any one person and \$10,000 for injuries and deaths for any one accident occurring during the time of the installation as a result of negligence of the registrant in making the installation and that such policy is not subject to cancellation except upon ten days notice to the City of Sweet Home. If such policy is cancelled during the registration period, the registration is automatically revoked and the registrant must forthwith surrender his registration card to the Building Inspector.

Section 2:

The Council deems it expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after it is passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
