

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 28 FOR 1953

ORDINANCE NO. 260

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE MUNICIPAL COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Except as otherwise provided by the constitution and statutes of the State of Oregon, and the Charter of the City of Sweet Home, all proceedings in the Municipal Court shall be governed and regulated by the general laws of the state applicable to Justice Courts in like or similar cases.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the Charter and ordinances of the City of Sweet Home do not now contain general provisions for the government of proceedings in the Municipal Court and a code of procedure for the Municipal Court is immediately desirable, the Council finds that an emergency exists affecting the health, peace and welfare of the citizens of Sweet Home and that it is expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately, and therefore this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon being passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.


