

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 21 FOR 1953

ORDINANCE BILL 251

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 4 AND SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 39 ENTITLED "DEFINING THE TERM 'ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR'; DECLARING THE POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION, SALE, DISPOSAL, USE, PURCHASE, OR ANY OTHER ACQUISITION OR DISPOSITION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AS HEREIN DEFINED CONTRARY TO THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF OREGON OR THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA OR THE DULY PROMULGATED RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE OREGON LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION TO BE UNLAWFUL; DECLARING CERTAIN OTHER ACTS AND THINGS RELATIVE TO THE PURCHASE, POSSESSION AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR TO BE UNLAWFUL; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;" PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR APRIL 27, 1937 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 and Section 7 of Ordinance No. 39 entitled "Defining the term 'alcoholic liquor'; declaring the possession, transportation, sale, disposal, use, purchase, or any other acquisition or disposition of alcoholic liquor as herein defined contrary to the laws of the State of Oregon or the United States of America or the duly promulgated rules and regulations of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to be unlawful; declaring certain other acts and things relative to the purchase, possession and sale of alcoholic liquor to be unlawful; providing a penalty for the violation hereof; repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith; and declaring an emergency;" passed by the council and approved by the Mayor on April 27, 1937, and each thereof are hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Council deems it expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately and this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon being passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
