

PROCLAMATION

~~Ordinance No. for 1963
Ordinance No. 416~~

WHEREAS, there has been put to the voters of the City of Sweet Home, an ordinance entitled:

"An Ordinance prohibiting the running at large of dogs within the City of Sweet Home; providing for the enforcement of state dog license statute; providing for the taking up of dogs running at large and the selling of, disposal of, and killing of such dogs; repealing all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith heretofore passed by the Council of the City of Sweet Home; and declaring an emergency".

which ordinance was voted upon on June 10, 1963; and

WHEREAS, the results of said election have been counted, canvassed, and returned; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 379 provides that the Mayor shall issue a proclamation as follows;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WILLIAM J. PENNEY, Mayor of the City of Sweet Home, Oregon, DO PROCLAIM:

Section 1. The outcome of the voting on the ordinance described above was:

YES 180
NO 157

and a majority of those who voted on the proposal were in favor of it.

Section 2. The ordinance shall be effective from the date of the vote, June 10, 1963, and shall be given the number of Ordinance No. 416.

Section 3. The City Recorder shall publish and post this proclamation as required by Ordinance No. 379, and shall file this proclamation with the proposal.
