

ORDINANCE NO. 7 for 1963

ORDINANCE NO. 417

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO ZONE AS RESIDENTIAL ZONE TWO, AND AS COMMERCIAL ZONE THREE AREAS PREVIOUSLY UNZONED; INCLUDING FRATERNAL LODGES AS A PERMITTED USE IN RESIDENTIAL ZONE TWO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the below mentioned amendments have been initiated by the City Council, favorably reviewed and recommended by the City Planning Commission given proper notice as required by State law and city ordinance, and a public hearing held thereon on May 14, 1963; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it desirable to make said zoning changes; NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section three of Ordinance 385, as amended to date, is hereby amended to include as Residential Zone Two all of that property within the city limits, west of Milburn Second Addition, annexed August 12, 1958, and to include as Commercial Zone Three all of that area on the north and south sides of M Street annexed into the City January 23 and August 14, 1962.

Section 2. Section five of Ordinance 385, as amended, is hereby amended to include fraternal lodges as a permitted use in Residential Zone Two.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the mayor.
