

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 34 FOR 1966

ORDINANCE NO. 497

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TRAFFIC ORDINANCE NO. 380, TO ADOPT ADDITIONAL SECTIONS OF THE STATE TRAFFIC ACT AND TO PROVIDE A 48 HOUR LIMIT ON PARKING ON PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

AN ORDINANCE

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 380 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of State Traffic Act. The following enumerated motor vehicle laws of Oregon, together with all acts and amendments applicable to cities which are now or hereafter enacted, are hereby adopted by reference and (made) a part of this ordinance:

The definitions in ORS Chapter 483 shall apply, where the context requires, to all other sections of this ordinance.

Section 10 of Ordinance No. 380 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Prohibited Parking. In addition to provisions of the Motor Vehicle Laws of Oregon prohibiting parking, no person shall park:

(a) A vehicle upon any bridge, viaduct or other elevated structure used as a street or within a street tunnel in this city, unless marked or indicated otherwise.

- (b) A vehicle in any alley except to load or unload persons or materials not to exceed 20 consecutive minutes in any two-hour period.
- (c) A vehicle upon any street for the principal purpose of:
- (1) Displaying such vehicle for sale.
 - (2) Washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle except repairs necessitated by an emergency.
 - (3) Selling merchandise from such vehicle except in a duly established market place or when so authorized or licensed under the ordinances of this city.
 - (4) Storage, or as junkage or dead storage for more than 15 hours.
- (d) A vehicle upon any parkway except where specifically authorized.
- (e) A vehicle upon any street or alley for more than 48 hours.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the city of Sweet Home, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

ADOPTION OF ADDITIONAL
SECTIONS OF THE STATE TRAFFIC ACT

- ORS 481.330 Dealers plates do not apply to dealers branches or agencies located in other cities.
- ORS 483.002 Defines authorized emergency vehicles, including police, fire, public service and ambulances used for emergency services. Also includes other definitions.
- ORS 483.006 Defines combination of vehicles as two or more vehicles coupled together. Also defines crosswalks.
- ORS 483.448 Requires vehicles to be equipped with mufflers in good working condition, prohibits muffler cut-outs and prohibits unreasonable noise. (Under our present provisions, we can prosecute only on inadequate mufflers. We can prosecute better under this statute.)
- ORS 483.450 Requires rear view mirrors.
- ORS 483.452 Prohibits obstruction of windows and requires windshield wipers.
- ORS 483.454 Requires light or flag at end of load that extends four feet or more beyond rear of vehicle.
- ORS 483.456 Requires fenders-and-vehicles and flaps on vehicles.
- ORS 483.462 Requires speedometers on taxis.
- ORS 483.474 Requires minimum roadway clearance (We have had nothing in our ordinances to require this.)
- ORS 483.482 Requires safety belts.
- ORS 483.630 In regard to sobriety tests was repealed and replaced by the implied consent law. It is my opinion that we do not need to adopt the implied consent law, as it relates to procedure and applies to the procedure in our courts without adoption by ordinance.
