

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 33 FOR 1965

ORDINANCE NO. 496

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFENSES ORDINANCE NO. 371; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;

Section 3, of Ordinance No. 371 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Intoxication. No person shall be intoxicated upon any street or highway or in any public place or building. No persons shall be intoxicated on or in any private place or building, unless he is the lawful owner or occupant thereof, or is the guest of the lawful owner or occupant thereof.

Section 10, of Ordinance No. 371 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Escape of Prisoners from Custody.

(1) No person shall aid or attempt to aid in the escape of a confined prisoner or make available or provide anything calculated to aid in such escape.

(2) No person shall knowingly aid an escaped prisoner by offering shelter, clothing, food or any other thing or service which would aid or abet the escape of such prisoner.

(3) No person shall escape from custody.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the city of Sweet Home, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
