

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 31 FOR 1965

ORDINANCE NO. 494

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.120, the City Council elects to dispense with submitting the question of annexation to the registered voters of the City of Sweet Home, as to whether the boundaries of the City of Sweet Home shall be altered and the contiguous new territory hereinafter described included therein, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is S.0°15'E, 159.49 feet from a one-half inch iron rod, said rod being at the north east corner of that certain tract of land deeded in Volume 264, page 818, Linn County Deed Records; thence S.0°15'E, 423.85 feet along the east line of said tract; thence N.89°26'W, 782.00 feet to the southeast corner of that certain tract of land deeded in Volume 247, page 497, Linn County Deed Records; thence N.0°15'W, 200.00 feet along the east line of said tract to the northeast corner of said tract; thence N.76°53'E., 602.065 feet; thence N.0°15'W, 34.10 feet; thence N.76°53'E, 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. In compliance with the provisions of ORS 222.120, a public hearing is hereby set for January 11, 1966, at the regular City Council meeting to be held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, the purpose of which hearing shall be to hear and consider any objections to the proposed annexation of the area above described.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby directed to publish notice of such hearing for two successive weeks prior to the hearing, in compliance with the provisions of ORS 222.120.

Section 4. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, and that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval.
