

ORDINANCE BILL #28 for 1965

ORDINANCE NO. 491

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF LARCH STREET; PROVIDING FOR STATUTORY PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, petitions have been received from the owners of abutting properties, and from property owners in the adjacent area affected, as described in ORS 271.080, for the vacation of a portion of Larch Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has initiated vacation proceedings, and has had notices provided, all as required by ORS 271.130; and

WHEREAS, no objections have been received to said proposed vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That portion of Larch Street described as follows:

That portion of Larch Street, formerly known as L Lane, described as follows, to-wit; Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 6, Block 6, Weddle's Addition to the City of Sweet Home, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence South 1°30' West 60 feet; thence South 89° West 129.95 feet; thence North 1°30' East 60 feet; thence North 89° East 129.95 feet to the point of beginning.

shall be and is hereby vacated, as provided by ORS 271.120, with title to said vacated street to attach to the lands bordering on such area in equal portions, as provided by ORS 271.140;

Section 2. The City Recorder shall file with the County Recorder a certified copy of this ordinance, with copies also filed with the County Assessor and County Surveyor, as required by ORS 271.150.

Section 3. It is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Sweet Home that this ordinance go into effect at once, and this ordinance shall be immediately effective and in full force upon its adoption by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
