

ORDINANCE BILL NO 26 FOR 1965

ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDINANCE NO. 380 TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH TRAFFIC REGULATIONS BY RESOLUTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Sweet Home Does Ordain:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 380 shall be amended to read:

"Section 3. POWERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL. The council, provided where required by the Motor Vehicle Laws of Oregon approval of the State Highway Commission has first been obtained, may by resolution establish or alter traffic controls and parking controls which shall become effective upon the installation of appropriate signs, signals or other markings."

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, and that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval.
