

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 5 FOR 1957

ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 169, CONCERNING THE DISPOSITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES COMING INTO THE HANDS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance #169 of the City of Sweet Home be amended

as follows:

(1) By adding to Section 1 of the said Ordinance a paragraph

to be designated section 1(1) and reading as follows:

" 1(1) An automobile left unoccupied and unclaimed or in a damaged or dismantled condition upon the streets or alleys of the City of Sweet Home for more than 3 days shall be considered abandoned and shall constitute a public nuisance."

(2) By designating section 1 of Ordinance #169 Section 1(2).

(3) By inserting in the said Section 1(2) between the words "shall" and "be" on line two thereof, the words "constitute a nuisance or shall".

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and it is declared to be for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Sweet Home that this ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, and it is so Ordered.
