

ORDINANCE NO. 9 for 1967

ORDINANCE NO. 534

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 252, CHANGING THE PROCEDURE FOR ABATEMENT OF WEEDS, GRASS AND BRUSH.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance 252 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. After the notice required by the preceding section has been given, if such weeds, grass, and brush have not been cut, removed and destroyed as hereby required, the Chief of Police shall cause such weeds, grass, and brush to be cut, removed and destroyed.

Section 2. Section 6 of Ordinance 252 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 6. After the Chief of Police has caused such weeds, grass and brush to be cut, removed and destroyed, the Chief of Police shall promptly report to the City Manager the cost thereof on each lot or parcel of land.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
