ORDINANCE NO. 533

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 369, PROHIBITING THE PURCHASE, POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR BY MINORS.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 369 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 4. Purchase or Possession of Liquor by Minor.
No person under the age of 21 years shall attempt to purchase, purchase or acquire alcoholic liquor. Except when such minor is in a private residence accompanied by his parent or guardian and with such parent's or guardian's consent, no person under the age of 21 years shall have in his possession alcoholic liquor.

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 369 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. Lawful Consumption of Liquor by Minor.
For the purposes of Section 4 of this Ordinance, possession of alcoholic liquor includes the acceptance or consumption of a bottle of such liquor, or any portion thereof or a drink of such liquor. However, the provisions of Section 4 of this Ordinance do not prohibit the consumption by any person of sacramental wine as part of a religious rite or service.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
