

ORDINANCE NO. 529
ORDINANCE NO. 4 for 1967

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT JAYWALKING AND PLAYING IN STREETS,
AND TO REGULATE PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC.

The City of Sweet Home does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to cross any of the streets in the area of the City of Sweet Home designated as the fire zone at any other place than the regular intersection crossing in line with the property line of said street upon an area which would be covered with the sidewalk if extended or at such other places as shall be designated as pedestrian lanes by appropriate markers on the street surfacing indicating the boundaries of such pedestrian crossings.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to play games in or to make use of any portion of the street between the curbs reserved for vehicular traffic in any portion of the city of Sweet Home designated as the fire zone for any other purpose than for vehicles excepting that pedestrians may cross said streets at the places designated in the foregoing section.


SECTION 3. Pedestrians, when using any street or highway within the city limits, shall use the left-hand side of such street or highway so as to leave the right-hand side free for vehicles passing the same direction and for safety in meeting vehicles proceeding in the opposite direction. Pedestrians shall use the sidewalks along the streets and highways, wherever such sidewalks are open for use.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any provision of this act shall upon conviction thereof in the municipal court be subject to a fine of not less than \$2.00 and not more than \$25.00.


SECTION 5. Ordinance No. 197 and Ordinance No. 207 are hereby repealed.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Sweet Home, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
