ORDINANCE NO. 539

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 344, PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF SIGNS ON DANGEROUS BUILDINGS.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance 344 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 5. Every building or part thereof which shall hereafter be found by the common council to be a dangerous building, is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, and the same may be abated either by the procedure hereinabove specified, or a suit for abatement thereof may be brought by the city of Sweet Home in the circuit court of Linn County, Oregon. The Council may cause to be posted at each entrance to such building a notice to read: "DO NOT ENTER, UNSAFE TO OCCUPY. Building Department, City of Sweet Home." Such notice shall remain posted until the required repairs, demolition, or removal are completed. Such notice shall not be removed without written permission of the Building Official and no person shall enter the building except for the purpose of making the required repairs or of demolishing the building.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
