ORDINANCE No. 36. 1936 2 3 4 AN ORDINANCE regulating peddling within the City of Sweet Home, defining peddler and peddle, and declaring an 5 6 emergency. 7 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DO ORDAIN AS 8 FOLLOWS: -9 Section 1. Peddler peddling any goods, wares or merchandise within the City of Sweet Home, when travelling by motor 10 driven vehicles or by animal or animals shall pay a license of 11 \$25.00 per day; provided, however, that any persons peddling 12 meat within the said City shall pay a license of \$25.00 per day. 13 Section 2. PEDDLERS DEFINED: The term "peddler", as 14 used in this Ordinance means and includes the following persons: 15 16 (1) Every person who, for himself or as agent for another goes 17 from place to place or from house to house, carrying for sale 18 of offering or exposing for sale any goods, wares or merchandise, and (2), every person who for himself or as agent of another. 19 goes from place to place or from house to house, selling or 20 offering for sale for future delivery, by sample or catalogue, 21 at retail to individual persons who are not dealers in the articles 22 sold, any goods, wares or merchandise. 23

Section 3. PEDDLER DEFINED: The term "peddle", as used 1 in this Ordinance means and includes any sale or exposing for sale of any goods, wares or merchandise by a peddler in pursuit of his occupation as a peddler. 4 Section 4. This Ordinance shall not apply to nor include 5 any peddling or selling of any agriculture or farm products or nursery products by the producer thereof or his employee, or of any goods, wares or merchandise of the person peddling the same which are of his own manufacture of the person peddling such goods of 10 wares. Section 5. Any peddler as defined by this Ordinance 11 desiring to peddle any goods, wares or merchandise, shall apply to 12 the Recorder of the City of Sweet Home for a license, setting 13 forth in his application the name, residence and occupation 14 of the peddler, and the kind of goods, wares and merchandise 15 sought to be peddled and sold, and shall pay the amount of the 16 license in advance to said recorder. Upon a demand by the mayor, 17 recorder or marshal of the City of Sweet Home such peddler shall 18 produce such license as so issued by the Recorder, and in the event 19 of his failure so to produce the same, such failure shall be 20 prima facea evidence that such peddler does not have such license. 21 Section 6. Any person or persons violating any of the 22 provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an mis-23 demeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's 24 Court of the City of Sweet Home, shall be fined not less than 25 \$25.00 not more than \$100.00 for each offense, and in the event 26 such fine shall not be paid, then shall be placed in the city jail 27

not less than 12 days not more than 50 days.

Section 7. Whereas, peddlers are operating within 1 2 the City of Sweet Home without the payment of any license fee, 3 to the deteriment of the people of said City, AN EMERGENCY IS 4 HEREBY DECLARED TO EXIST, and to preserve the peace, health and 5 safety of the inhabitants of the City of Sweet Home this Ordinance 6 shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption 7 and approval.
