4 AN ORDINANCE regulating peddling within the City of
5 Sweet Home, defining peddler and peddle, and declaring an
6 emergency.

7 THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DO ORDAIN AS
8 FOLLOWS:-

9 Section 1. Peddler peddling any goods, wares or mer-
10 chandise within the City of Sweet Home, when travelling by motor
11 driven vehicles or by animal or animals shall pay a license of
12 \$25.00 per day; provided, however, that any persons peddling
13 meat within the said City shall pay a license of \$25.00 per day.

14 Section 2. PEDDLERS DEFINED: The term "peddler", as
15 used in this Ordinance means and includes the following persons:
16 (1) Every person who, for himself or as agent for another goes
17 from place to place or from house to house, carrying for sale
18 of offering or exposing for sale any goods, wares or merchandise,
19 and (2), every person who for himself or as agent of another,
20 goes from place to place or from house to house, selling or
21 offering for sale for future delivery, by sample or catalogue,
22 at retail to individual persons who are not dealers in the articles
23 sold, any goods, wares or merchandise.

1 Section 3. PEDDLER DEFINED: The term "peddle", as used
2 in this Ordinance means and includes any sale or exposing for
3 sale of any goods, wares or merchandise by a peddler in pursuit
4 of his occupation as a peddler.

5 Section 4. This Ordinance shall not apply to nor include
6 any peddling or selling of any agriculture or farm products or
7 nursery products by the producer thereof or his employee, or of any
8 goods, wares or merchandise of the person peddling the same which
9 are of his own manufacture of the person peddling such goods of
10 wares.

11 Section 5. Any peddler as defined by this Ordinance
12 desiring to peddle any goods, wares or merchandise, shall apply to
13 the Recorder of the City of Sweet Home for a license, setting
14 forth in his application the name, residence and occupation
15 of the peddler, and the kind of goods, wares and merchandise
16 sought to be peddled and sold, and shall pay the amount of the
17 license in advance to said recorder. Upon a demand by the mayor,
18 recorder or marshal of the City of Sweet Home such peddler shall
19 produce such license as so issued by the Recorder, and in the event
20 of his failure so to produce the same, such failure shall be
21 prima facea evidence that such peddler does not have such license.

22 Section 6. Any person or persons violating any of the
23 provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an mis-
24 demeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's
25 Court of the City of Sweet Home, shall be fined not less than
26 \$25.00 not more than \$100.00 for each offense, and in the event
27 such fine shall not be paid, then shall be placed in the city jail
28 not less than 12 days not more than 50 days.

1 Section 7. Whereas, peddlers are operating within
2 the City of Sweet Home without the payment of any license fee,
3 to the detriment of the people of said City, AN EMERGENCY IS
4 HEREBY DECLARED TO EXIST, and to preserve the peace, health and
5 safety of the inhabitants of the City of Sweet Home this Ordinance
6 shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption
7 and approval.
