

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 8, 1937

ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 32 of the City of Sweet Home, entitled, "An Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same, and providing for the punishment thereof", passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor April 16, 1929, by adding thereto Section 1-A, concerning drunkenness in public places.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 32 of the City of Sweet Home, entitled, "An Ordinance concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same, and providing for the punishment thereof", passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor, April 16, 1929, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto between Sections 1 and 2 a section to be known as Section 1-A, which Section 1-A shall read as follows:-

"Section 1-A. It shall be unlawful for any person to be drunk in any highway, street, or in any other public place building, or for any person to be drunk in any private building or place and disturbing others, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, be imprisoned in the city jail not less than five days nor more than fifty days."
