## **RESOLUTION NO. 34 FOR 2022**

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING STREET CLOSURES AND RESTRICTIONS.

WHEREAS, traffic patterns and parking issues need to be addressed to safely accommodate the Parade of Lights event; and

WHEREAS, Sweet Home Municipal Code 10.04.030 provides that the City Council may, by resolution, establish or alter traffic and parking control;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Sweet Home does resolve as follows:

Traffic regulations shall be as follows:

- A. Public Works Department will place "No Parking" signs at 4:00 PM and close indicated streets at 5:00 PM. Street closures will be as follows: Long Street from 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the south side of Main Street from 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The north side of Main Street will be used for two-way traffic during the parade. The following intersections will also be closed:12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Main Street, 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Long Street, 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Main Street, 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Main Street, 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Long Street, 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Long Street, 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Long Street, 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Long Street
- B. Appropriate signs or other markings shall be installed by the Public Works Department to carry safely out the provisions of this resolution and shall become effective immediately upon the installation of such barricades, signs, or other markings.
