

ORDINANCE NO. 33.

An ordinance relating to the construction of sidewalks in the City of Sweet Home, state of Oregon, repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1. That sidewalks within the limits of the City of Sweet Home hereafter constructed shall be constructed as in this ordinance provided by the council.

Section 2. On all the streets that are 60 feet wide all sidewalks shall be 6 feet wide and constructed of red or yellow fir as follows: Bearings two inches thick and four inches wide shall be laid upon a firm foundation at a distance of not more than eight feet apart; on said bearings shall be laid three ties or stringers three inches by four inches wide, of suitable length, said stringers to be placed on the bearings at suitable and equal distance apart, and well secured by being nailed to the bearings with nails of suitable size (16). There shall be placed on said stringers decking of one and one-half inch plank, square edged and evenly sawed, and eight inches wide; such decking to be evenly and closely fitted together and well nailed to the stringers by 16 penny nails. The work shall be done in a substantial and workman like manner, and the incline of the sidewalk shall be not more than one fourth of an inch to the foot; unless otherwise ordered by the council all sidewalks shall be laid abutting the property line upon a grade furnished by the city marshal or the committee on the streets and public property.

Section 3. On all streets 55 feet wide or 50 feet wide all sidewalks shall be 5 feet wide. And on all streets 40 feet wide or less sidewalks shall be not less than 4 feet wide. Sidewalks constructed on streets of such width shall be conforming in all other respects in the same materials as the sidewalks described in section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 4. It shall be optional with the property owner or with any person duly authorized as an agent for such property owner, and with the consent of the city council, to provide a sidewalk conforming to the following specifications as stated in lieu of the specifications as stated in section 2. Gravel, in size not larger than one inch in diameter, shall be laid to a depth of three inches. Said gravel to be held in place by a dirt shoulder. The gravel as herein specified shall be mixed with a suitable binder of clay or dirt, and shall be smoothly spread to the widths specified in sections two and three.

Section 5. All private driveways across sidewalks, and alleys shall be constructed of gravel according to the specifications laid down in section 4; or they may be constructed of cement.

Section 6. The committee on streets and public property shall, by this ordinance, be given the power to condemn any or all sidewalks within the corporate City of Sweet Home, state of Oregon and shall order the repair and construction of same by notifying the owner or agent of such abutting property, and shall at the expiration of ten (10) days from date of such notification, and

upon the failure of such property owner or his agent to repair or construct such condemned sidewalks, proceed to repair or construct said sidewalks the expense of which shall be charged against the abutting property.

Section 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. As it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Sweet Home that provision be made for the construction of sidewalks in said city, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
