

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 10 FOR 1956

ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 290, FIXING AND ESTABLISHING WATER SERVICE RATES TO BE PAID BY ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTIES CONNECTED WITH OR USING THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 290, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on April 26, 1955, entitled "AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND ESTABLISHING WATER SERVICE RATES TO BE PAID BY ALL PERSONS AND PROPERTIES CONNECTED WITH OR USING THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF SWEET HOME, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF PAYMENT OF SUCH WATER RATES, AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 53, 99, 103, 106, 107, and 202, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY," is hereby amended as follows:

Section #5. The rates per 100 cubic feet of water to be charged are as follows:

Group I: For single-family dwellings actually used for residential purposes. A single-family dwelling is limited to dwellings in which not more than two (2) people who are not members of the immediate family live as members of the family.

First 200 cubic feet at 75¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.50
Next 500 cubic feet at 30¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.50
Next 700 cubic feet at 20¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.40
All over 1400 cubic feet at 10¢ per 100 cubic feet	

Group II: For all other structures within the city limits including two or more houses serviced by one meter:

First 200 cubic feet at 75¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.50
Next 300 cubic feet at 50¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.50
Next 400 cubic feet at 35¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.40
Next 500 cubic feet at 25¢ per 100 cubic feet	\$1.25
All over 1400 cubic feet at 10¢ per 100 cubic feet	

Group III: For all consumers outside the city limits the rate charged shall be  $1\frac{1}{2}$  times the rate charged to consumers in comparable groups within the city limits, except that the minimum rate shall be \$2.25 per month for all amounts up to and including 200 cubic feet.

Section 2. The Council deems it expedient that this ordinance take effect immediately, and an emergency exists affecting the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Sweet Home, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its being passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
