

**RESOLUTION NO. 16 FOR 2000**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM CONTINGENCY TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES LINE AND THE REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE LINE IN THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the DEQ permit needed to operate the wastewater system required new tests for e-coli; and

WHEREAS, the city did not have the equipment to perform this testing until late in the year resulting in the outsourcing of these tests; and

WHEREAS, the influent pumps in the wastewater plant needed to be rebuilt this year; and

WHEREAS, the cost of these services was unanticipated during the 1999-2000 budget process; and


WHEREAS, ORS 294.450 provides for the transfers of appropriations within a fund or from one fund to another by official resolution of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY OF SWEET HOME DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

To transfer \$10,000 from contingency to the Professional Services expense line and \$7,200 to the Repairs & Maintenance expense line in the Wastewater Treatment Fund.

This transfer would fund the cost of outsourcing new compliance tests required under the DEQ permit and rebuilding influent pumps.
